Jobcentre Plus

Recommended by: MAT ALAN
 You might find yourself at Jobcentre Plus to register for state benefits or establish what you're entitled to, but the site can also help you find employment. Indeed, MAT ALAN obtained his current job from the site.



The checklist of employment areas helps you identify the sorts of role you may be eligible for. You then drill down to find the job that's right for you.

1Job

Recommended by: Rachel LM
 Perhaps not as widely known as some of the other recruitment websites here, 1Job functions as an aggregator of the positions currently available - a bit like a job-focused search engine.
 Rachel LM used 1Job as a starting point in the hunt for her first post-university role. If you're interested in a position, 1Job takes you to the agency or specialist recruitment site. It's a scattergun approach, but with 300,000-plus listings, this could be worth a look.

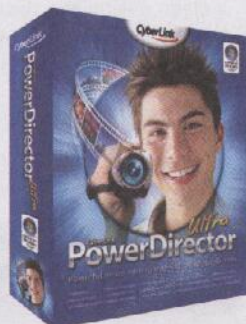


Jobsite
